

As a child in the 1930s Dorothy went with her father from Dragon Field Village to Guangdong's capital, Canton (Guangzhou), a city rife with beggars, crime and kidnapping. She always kept a piece of paper in her pocket with her name and address in case she lost her father's hand in the crowd

The ancestral home is at Long Tian Li (Dragon Field Village), Lechong Cun (Lechong Village Group), Sanbu (Three Ports) Town, Kaiping City, Jiangmen Prefecture, Guangdong Province, PRC 5293000

Pronunciation Gen Chung Henry: Chung as in Jung

Lehene as in Lay-HEEN Helene as in He-LANE Chung as in cHUNG

CHRONOLOGY

1901 Gin/Gen Chung begins as tin miner in northeast Tasmania 1904 Having sent his opium-addicted father home, becomes market gardener in Launceston 1906 Laundry in Barrack St, Hobart 1912 First return visit to China to see his mother 1916 Second visit, marries Sydney-born Mary Lum Lee 1918 Third visit, collects wife and baby Joyce c 1920 Gin Chung adopts 'Henry' as the family surname 1923 Fourth visit (with family), buys Canton properties 1924 Laundry (later with tobacco & fancy goods) at 152 Elizabeth St 1925 Tues 14 April Dorothy Henry born at 152 Elizabeth St 1927 Family moves to 153 Elizabeth St (fruit & vegetables, tobacco & fancy goods) 1930 Dorothy begins 3 years in leg irons due to lack of milk. She was weaned only on rice water 1931 Fifth visit (with family), new home Dragon Field Village, more Canton property 1932 Joyce baptised at Sacred Heart Cathedral, Canton, so introducing Catholicism into family 1933 Brisbane, fruit & vegetables 1934 Gen Chung Henry opens Henry & Co. at 139 Liverpool St, Hobart At 9, and with little English, Dorothy enrolls at St Columba's 1938 Moves to Elizabeth Street State School 1940 Gordon, Lester, Dorothy and Marie baptised by Fr Wallis in St Mary's Cathedral Dorothy commences at Commercial High School 1941 Gen Chung Henry baptised on his deathbed by Archbishop Simmonds 3 Feb Gen Chung Henry dies at 56 Dorothy is devastated and has a nervous breakdown 1942 Dorothy meets Charles (Pak Koon) Chung 1943 They marry and, helped by Willi Chung Sing, launch Chung Sing & Co. at 99 Liverpool St Thurs 2 Sep Lehene born at St Stephen's, Davey St 1945 Sat 20 Jan Helene born at Calvary 1945-46 Dorothy returns to Henry & Co. 1947 11 Oct Mary Lum Lee dies at 56 1948 Too old to be apprenticed, Dorothy enrolls in hairdressing in Sydney Also models for artists, meets Gordon Walters 1951 Dorothy and girls occupy brother Gordon's new house at Lenah Valley 1952-54 Return to living over the shop Dorothy sits in on philosophy and psychology lectures UTAS 1954 1st of series of rented houses with NZ radio announcer Rex Walden 1955 Red MG TF 1500 1958 Dorothy rents Hawthorn Dene, Longley, from Egyptologist Leslie Greener 1960 1st trip to Egypt, France, England 1961 Easter Saturday after theatre MG in head-on collision with 10-ton apple truck on Sandy Bay Rd

1962 Jaguar Mark II 2.4-litre manual drive

1966 29 Aug Rex dies at 47

Dorothy moves to 3 Lambert Avenue, Sandy Bay

1968 Finally accepts Leslie's decade-long marriage proposal

1969 Lehene leaves for Melbourne

1970 Helene leaves for Melbourne and overseas

1972-73 Dorothy, Leslie, Lehene and Helene reunion in England, Egypt

1974 Helene returns to Hobart

8 Dec Leslie dies at 74

1975 Dorothy visits Lehene in London

1977 Helene moves to Melbourne

Dorothy to Lehene's wedding in London

1979 Dorothy, Lehene and Helene Christmas in London

1984 Dorothy visits Hong Kong, Paris, London, Peking

1986 21 Jan Lester dies at 60

1988 18 May Fon dies at 75

Dorothy sells Jaguar Mark II after successive 1st prizes

1993 Wed 29 Sep Helene's husband, John Martin dies at 1:30pm aged 59

Sat 23 Oct Ashes ceremony for John at home on his 60th birthday

1995 15 Jul Gordon dies at 75

1997 Lehene reunited with 33-year-old son, Graham (adopted at birth)

1998 Dorothy and Helene to London to care for Lehene

1999 Sale of Lambert Avenue

2000 Dorothy and Helene return to London to care for Lehene

2001 Mon 1 Jan Lehene dies at 11:20pm aged 57

Sat 17 Feb Memorial Service for Lehene at St John's on her wedding anniversary Sun 2 Sep Ashes ceremony at Helene's for Lehene on her 58th birthday (Chung half of ashes)

28 Dec Dorothy moves into Nova Apartments, Melbourne

2008 20 Feb Joyce dies at 92

6 Jul Dorothy has heart attack followed by double bypass

2009 7 Jan Lehene's husband, David Goodenday dies at 84

2013 2 Oct Dorothy falls in dead of night enroute to bathroom and suffers hemorrhagic stroke

29 Nov admitted to Mercy Place Aged Care, East Melbourne

2014 5 May transfers to Rathdowne Place Aged Care, Carlton

2018 23 Dec Charles dies at 98

2019 26 Jul Marie dies at 91

11 Dec Dorothy falls trying to move from bed to bathroom and breaks her collarbone

2020 14 April marks her 95th birthday in total Covid-19 lockdown of 5 weeks with no visitors allowed 23 April Dorothy permitted visits from Helene

Jun - 2 Jul allowed to visit restaurants, before Covid-19 lockdown 2 enforced

Sat 17 Oct at 9pm Dorothy dies peacefully in Helene's arms

2021 Wed 20 Jan Dorothy's funeral and burial, interment of Lehene's Goodenday ashes
